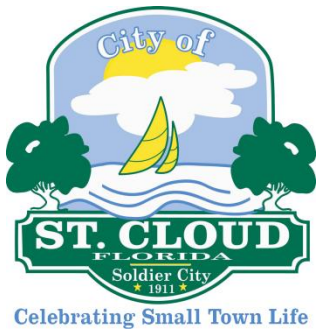
### *Poster Contest Rules*

- Kindergarten thru Third Grade student entries must meet one of the following criteria:
  1. City of St. Cloud utility customer or
  2. Student at school located in the St. Cloud Service Area (including Hickory Tree Elementary, Lakeview Elementary, Michigan Avenue Elementary, Narcoossee Elementary, Neptune Elementary, St. Cloud Elementary, Canoe Creek Charter Academy School, Southland Christian School, St. Thomas Aquinas School, Heartland Christian School)
- Winner selection will be based on message , creativity and originality
- Poster shall be drawn on a 8 ½" x 11" white paper.
- Each poster must portray a **Water Conservation Idea** in a slogan, drawing, or both. Students may use crayons, color pencils, or markers (not highlighters).
- Children of City of St. Cloud Public Services employees are not eligible.
- Students must work on posters individually, otherwise posters will be disqualified.
- Only original artwork will be accepted (i.e no trade-marked or copyrighted materials).
- Entry form must be taped or glued to the back of each poster.
- Entries must be submitted to:

- Entries must be received by March 8, 2012. Arrangements can be made in advance for posters to be picked up from participating schools.
